Title: 2025-08 Resolution for Grants Related to Florida Hurricane Debby, DR-4806-FL (B)

Department: Financial Services

Description: A resolution to enter into grant agreements with the Florida Division of Emergency Management via FEMA for eligible expenses related to Hurricane Debby.

Fiscal Note: FEMA Public Assistant Funds will provide reimbursements to various funding sources expended during the Hurricane Debby Declared State of Emergency in 2024.

Explanation: FEMA Public Assistance (PA) and Hazard Mitigation funding is available to the City of Gainesville through the Hurricane Debby Federal Disaster Declaration, DR-4806-FL.

Public Assistance funding will allow the City to recover the estimated \$30,000 costs for emergency protective measures taken in preparation for the storm such as its sandbag operations, Emergency Operations Center (EOC) staffing, and materials and supplies.
