

#### What a TDP is NOT:

- Budget
- Capital Improvement Program (CIP)
- Binding agreement

10-year vision for transit

 $\checkmark$ 

Plan that identifies both <u>funded & unfunded needs</u>

Collaborative process

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Helps RTS set transit service/capital priorities



Updated annually *Major update every 5 years* 

# What is a Transit Development Plan? Gainesville

- 10-year transit plan
- Strategic plan for transit
  - Evaluate demographics & travel behavior
  - Assess existing transit options
  - Conduct public involvement & outreach
  - Determine transit needs
  - Develop service & implementation plans
- FDOT requirement for funding

# **Transit Route Restoration Plan**

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
- Recommendations:
  - Phase 1 Collaboration and coordination of RTS staff incorporated UF-generated adjustments and repurposing of resources
  - Phase 2 Reflects UF's proposed Network Changes with minor modifications to RTS funded routes
  - Phase 3 TRRP Study recommendations, reflecting UF proposed network, modified RTS, Santa Fe College, and County routes






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

Phase 2 - County Network Overlay








