Project Overview

- Project site includes MLK Center, Citizens
 Field Stadium, DH Hunter Pool, Multipurpose fields, and Gainesville Fire Rescue Facilities (~36 total acres)
- Recommendations for NE 8th Avenue and NE Waldo Road improvements
- Public + Stakeholder Engagement
- Final deliverable includes the development of Preliminary Site Plan
 - Construction documentation + permitting to follow
- Anticipated to be completed in June 2025
 - Pending City Commission direction on final program facilities

- DH Hunter Pool is at the end of its life and requires replacement

- Making the facilities reflect the pride the community has in this complex












