A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida; relating to the levy of general municipal purpose Ad Valorem Taxes for the 2025-2026 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026; establishing a Tentative Millage Rate; setting a public hearing; providing for the publication of notice; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2025, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-569 approving the Proposed (Maximum/Not-To-Exceed) millage rate necessary to fund the proposed Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in Resolution No. 2025-569, on or about August 21, 2025, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year’s assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of the public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the tentative millage necessary to fund the said budget; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;
