(9-members; 2-year terms) (Resolution: 080049) CITY Residency REQUIRED.

The State Housing Initiatives Partnership Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (SHIP-AHAC) is created and established to recommend monetary and nonmonetary local housing incentive strategies to be included in the local housing assistance plan. In order to receive SHIP funds, the city is required to submit these plans to the state. The local housing incentives strategies analyze specific land development regulations and funding sources. In, addition, staff or the city commission may ask SHIP-AHAC to conduct public meetings to gather community input and to make policy recommendations to the city commission.

The SHIP-AHAC shall consist of eleven members. The composition of the committee shall include the following individuals as required by state law: (1) citizen who is actively engaged in the residential home building industry in connection with affordable housing; (2) citizen who is actively engaged in the banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing; (3) citizen who is a representative of those areas of labor actively engaged in home building in connection with affordable housing; (4) citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing; (5) citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing; (6) citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing; (6) citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing; (7) citizen who is actively engaged as a real estate professional in connection with affordable housing; (8) citizen who actively serves on the City Plan Board; (9) citizen who represents employers within the jurisdiction; (10) citizen who represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan; (11) other citizen.
