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1. Title of Project: Medical Assisted Treatment Program (MAT)
2. Date of Submission: 10/19/22
3. Amount Requested: 500,000.00
4. Recurring funds: Yes
5. Additional Funding: Matching Funding includes committed Personnel costs.
6. Project Justification: Medication-assisted treatment (MAT) is the use of medications, in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, to provide a “whole patient” approach to the treatment of substance use disorders. Medications used in MAT are approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and MAT programs are clinically driven and tailored to meet each patient’s needs. MAT has proved to be clinically effective and to significantly reduce the need for inpatient detoxification services for these individuals. MAT provides a more comprehensive, individually tailored program of medication and behavioral therapy that address the needs of most patients. The ultimate goal of MAT is full recovery, including the ability to live a self-directed life. The Health Director would coordinate resources through the Community Resource Paramedicine (CRP) Program.
