Property on SW 13th Street (B)

Department: Sustainable Development

Description: This is the submission of a petition for the voluntary annexation of parcel 07251-019-000, located at 3926 SW 13th Street, owned by Tyagiji LLC. This parcel is generally located west of SW 13th Street, south of tax parcels 07251-009-001 and 07251-009-002, east of SW 15th Street, and north of SW Williston Road.

Fiscal Note: N/A

Explanation: This is the acceptance of a voluntary annexation petition, giving staff authorization to begin research and initiate the voluntary annexation process under state statute. Two public hearings before the City Commission with two opportunities for public comment will take place before the annexation becomes effective. In order to annex these parcels into the City limits, the owners must submit a petition to the City of Gainesville for voluntary annexation. The staff has reviewed the requirements of the Municipal Annexation or Contraction Act (Chapter 171, Florida Statutes). This area meets the requirements of the Act and is appropriate for annexation.
