C. BUSINESS DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. 2023-794 Comprehensive Plan Update (B)

Forrest Eddleton, Acting Director of Sustainable Development, gave a presentation on the update to the city's Comprehensive Plan. Also, he spoke about including equitable development, the ten-year planning horizon, how the Live Local Act will be incorporated, and how equity will be operationalized in updating the Land Development Code. The new

Gainesville Regional Utilities Authority should not impact the Comprehensive Plan meaningfully.

Cynthia Curry, City Manager, spoke to the item in regard to the equitable development piece of the Comprehensive Plan and how the Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion is being utilized to collect data from traditionally underrepresented communities. Community engagement will continue, including in the Azalea Trails neighborhood.

Brittany McMullen, Planner IV, spoke to the item in regard to the change in how the original plan is different from the draft Comprehensive Plan when it comes to equity. The Live Local Act, which started July 1, 2023, preempts municipalities from saying "no" to high-density developments with a certain amount of affordable housing elements, removed home rule for height requirements in higher-density zoning, and does not apply to residential zoning districts.

Nathanial Chan, Planner III, spoke to the item on the data analysis the Comprehensive Plan is based on.
