 - 3. Following is a review of the Pre-Bid Meeting that was held via Zoom Conference on May 23, 2023, 3:30pm Eastern Time:
 - a. City of Gainesville Staff represented by Gayle Dykeman, City of Gainesville Procurement Specialist III and David Roque, Project Manager.
 - b. Gayle Dykeman started the meeting by reviewing important Procurement areas of the solicitation, including the solicitation schedule and submittal due date.
 - 1. All communication must go through Gayle Dykeman throughout the duration of the solicitation.
 - 2. All submittals must be entered in DemandStar.com by the due date and time DemandStar is programmed to reject any bids that are entered after that time.
 - 3. Reviewed the guidance regarding the Cone of Silence.
 - 4. Required forms updated on the Meeting Checklist form attached
 - c. David Roque provided an overview of the intent of the solicitation.



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4. Following are questions and answers that were discussed in the meeting:

a. <u>Question:</u>

Regarding minimum qualifications, how do you define Respondent? Must the Respondent be an individual firm *(meaning the firm has been in business a minimum of three years)* or is it fine if staff members have three or more years of experience with the development, implementation and completion of African American cultural and heritage trails?

Answer:

The Respondent Company's project team leadership must each have a minimum of three (3) years of experience in the development, implementation and completion of African American cultural and heritage trails, as evidenced through the submittal of CVs or resumes.

b. <u>Question:</u>

Would the City of Gainesville like to see a digital component to the heritage trail included?

Answer:

Yes, this information was not included in the solicitation's Scope of Work, but should be considered as part of the scope of work and included in the proposals.

c. Question:

Are the points of interest and key sites finalized or is part of the community engagement to finalize them?

Answer:

Part of community engagement is to finalize the points of interest and key sites.

d. Question:

The documents show initial concepts completed by Manley Design and Community Solutions Group. Are those to be considered as part of the project or is there interest in starting from scratch? What is the history of the community engagement around those initial concepts?

Answer:

The initial concepts have not been presented to the community stakeholders or CRA board. What is in the package is not caste in stone.

e. Question:

Is there an expected tie in with the 6th Street Trail wayfinding signage or will the heritage trail be entirely separate?

Answer:

6th Street Trail has its own branding and is a separate project.

FINANCIAL SERVICES PROCEDURES MANUAL

41-424 Prohibition of lobbying in procurement matters

Except as expressly set forth in Resolution 170116, Section 9, during the Cone of Silence as defined herein no person may lobby, on behalf of a competing party in a particular procurement process, City Officials or employees, except the Procurement Division or the procurement designated staff contact person. Violation of this provision shall result in disqualification of the party on whose behalf the lobbying occurred.

Cone of Silence period means the period between the issue date which allows for immediate submittals to the City of Gainesville Procurement Division in response to an invitation to bid, or a request for proposal, or qualifications, or information, or an invitation to negotiate, as applicable, and the time that City Officials or the Procurement Division, or City Department awards the contract.

Lobbying means when a person seeks to influence or attempt to influence City Officials or employees with respect to a decision of the City, except as authorized by procurement procedures.
