3. Scotty Goodloe, Procurement Division, discussed bid requirements.
 - a. Sign-in Sheet is circulating.
 - b. Bids are to be received electronically through Demandstar no later than 3:00 p.m. on February 25, 2020. Any bids received after 3:00 p.m. on that date will not be accepted.
 - i. Discussed bid questions deadline, due date, time and delivery location.
 - c. Send questions in writing to Scotty Goodloe via email or fax.
 - i. All communication through Scotty Goodloe. Do not communicate with other City Staff.
 - d. Discussed various forms (Living Wage, Local Preference, Reference Form, Minimum Requirements, Bonds)
 - i. Discussed proposal submission instructions, evaluation process
 - ii. Sign, date and upload all forms and addendums with submittal.
4. Scott Wright, Mobility Project Manager discussed the overview of different projects for this RFQ. Multiple projects for trails, multi-use paths, curb construction, minor roadway construction, sidewalks, and bus stop improvements. These projects will come out of the annual sidewalk budget or other available fund.

5. John Veilleux, Public Works Engineer discussed bonding limits for projects that exceed \$250,000. He also discussed how vendors will be selected for individual projects. When projects arise, the contractor will be provided a detailed description of the project scope (plans and specifications) and asked to provide a unit price or lump sum price proposal for completing the work.
6. Question: Will living wage be required for projects that are less than \$50,000?
Answer: No
7. Question: Are most of the projects in the Gainesville City limits?
Answer: Yes
8. Question: Should design firms submit Qualifications for this RFQ?
Answer: No, design for each project will be done internally by the City.
9. Question: Who is responsible for the material testing during projects?
Answer: The contractor is responsible.
10. Question: How much are the project estimates?
Answer: Each project varies depending on size, there is a \$2 million cap (not to exceed) on each project.
11. Question: How long is the contract for this solicitation?
Answer: The initial term is for 3 years with 2 possible (1) year extensions.
12. Question: Are bonds due at the time of the submittal?
Answer: No, bonds will be due when the project is awarded. The bond is based on project size. Bond is required for projects over \$250,000.
13. Question: Do any of the projects require vegetation removal?
Answer: Some projects may require demo and/or planting.
14. Question: Do we need to submit pricing?
Answer: No, the City is looking to qualify multiple vendors so they can choose from different vendors as projects arise. The City is seeking to have multiple vendors under continuing service contracts.

CITY OF _____ FINANCIAL SERVICES GAINESVILLE PROCEDURES MANUAL

41-424 Prohibition of lobbying in procurement matters

Except as expressly set forth in Resolution 170116, Section 9, during the Cone of Silence as defined herein no person may lobby, on behalf of a competing party in a particular procurement process, City Officials or employees, except the Procurement Division or the procurement designated staff contact person. Violation of this provision shall result in disqualification of the party on whose behalf the lobbying occurred.

Cone of Silence period means the period between the issue date which allows for immediate submittals to the City of Gainesville Procurement Division in response to an invitation to bid, or a request for proposal, or qualifications, or information, or an invitation to negotiate, as applicable, and the time that City Officials or the Procurement Division, or City Department awards the contract.


Lobbying means when a person seeks to influence or attempt to influence City Officials or employees with respect to a decision of the City, except as authorized by procurement procedures.


