

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-1033

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute and enter into agreements, and any other necessary documents, on behalf of the City, with the Florida Division of Emergency Management for a Mason Manor Buyout; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) manages the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (PROGRAM); and,

WHEREAS, funding for qualified mitigation projects is available under the PROGRAM under Hurricane Irma Disaster Declaration FEMA 4337-DR-FL; and,

WHEREAS, the Mason Manor Buyout (acquisition and demolition), Project 4337-042-R Phase II (PROJECT) has been prioritized and incorporated into the Alachua County Local Mitigation Plan and qualifies for funding under the PROGRAM; and,

WHEREAS, the PROJECT has been approved by FEMA to receive grant funding under the PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to submit a grant application to FDEP under the PROGRAM for the PROJECT; and

Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute and enter into agreements, and any other necessary documents, with the FDEM under the PROGRAM for the PROJECT on behalf of the CITY, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality; and

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
