An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon, and close a certain public right-of-way generally located in the portion of SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and SW 1<sup>st</sup> Street abutting tax parcels 14557-000-000, 12994-000-000, and 12997-000-000, as more specifically described in this ordinance; providing directions to the City Clerk; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

whereas, the City of Gainesville, Florida, is a duly constituted municipality having the broad exercise of home rule authority conferred upon it by Article VIII, Section 2 of the Florida Constitution and the Municipal Home Rule Powers Act, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, including the exercise of any power for municipal purposes not expressly prohibited by law; and whereas, pursuant to Section 30-3.41 of the City of Gainesville's Land Development Code (Chapter 30 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances), an application was initiated by the owner(s) of land abutting the subject public right-of-way requesting the City to vacate, abandon, and close the right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the request to vacate the subject public right-of-way was presented to and approved

by the appropriate departments of the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts pursuant to the authority granted in Section 4.02 of

the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville and which acts as the Local Planning Agency pursuant

to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on August 24, 2023, and voted to

recommend that the City Commission approve this vacation of public right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS,** at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general

circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be held by

the City Commission of the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above at which hearings

the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; and

- 1 WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the vacation of the subject right-of-way meets the
- 2 required criteria in Policy 10.2.1 of the Transportation Mobility Element of the Comprehensive
- 3 Plan and Section 30-3.41 of the Land Development Code.
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,
- 5 **FLORIDA:**
- 6 **SECTION 1**. The following described public right-of-way is hereby vacated, abandoned, and
- 7 closed for use by the public generally:
- See legal description attached as **Exhibit A** and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on **Exhibit B** for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, **Exhibit A** shall prevail over **Exhibit B**.

- 12 **SECTION 2.** The City reserves unto itself, its successors, and assigns a public and private
- utilities easement over, under, across, and through the property described in Section 1 of this
- ordinance for the purpose of installing, maintaining, and operating public and private utilities
- including stormwater management.
- 16 **SECTION 3.** The City Clerk or designee is authorized to record a true copy of this ordinance in
- the public records of Alachua County, Florida.
- SECTION 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance or
- the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
- finding will not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
- 21 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
- 22 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- 23 **SECTION 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
- 24 conflict hereby repealed.

<b>SECTION 6.</b> This ordinance will become 6	effective immediately upon adoption.

## **Legal Description**

A portion of Section 5, Township 10 South, Range 20 East, City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida; being more particularly described as follows:

That portion of S.W. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue 40' Right of Way (formerly known as McCormick Street) lying East of the East Right of Way line of S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (40' Right of way) and lying West of the West Right of Way line of South Main Street (90' Right of Way).

## Together with:


That portion of S.W. 1<sup>st</sup> Street 40' Right of Way lying North of the North Right of Way line of S.W. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Right of Way Width Varies) and lying South of the South Right of Way line of S.W. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue (formerly known as McCormick Street, 40' Right of Way).


Said portions of S.W. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and S.W. 1<sup>st</sup> Street Right of Ways being further described as follows:

Commence at a railroad spike at the intersection of the North Right of Way line of S.W. 4th Avenue (Right of Way width varies) with the West Right of Way line of South Main Street (90' Right of Way) and run thence North 01°16'36" West, along said West Right of Way line, 193.32 feet to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on the South Right of Way line of S.W. 3rd Avenue (formerly known as McCormick Street, 40' Right of Way) and the Point of Beginning; thence northerly, along said West Right of Way line of South Main Street, 40 feet, more or less, to a nail and disk (PSM 5469) on the North Right of Way line of said S.W. 3rd Avenue; thence South 88°31'31" West, along said North Right of Way line of S.W. 3rd Avenue, 439.18 feet to a nail and disk (PSM 5469) on the East Right of Way line of S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (40' Right of Way); thence southerly, along said East Right of Way line of S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, 40 feet, more or less, to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on the South Right of Way line of said S.W. 3rd Avenue; thence North 88°13'48" East, along said South Right of Way line of S.W. 3rd Avenue, 200.22 feet to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on the West Right of Way line of S.W. 1st Street (40' Right of Way); thence South 01°21'27" East, along said West Right of Way line of S.W. 1st Street, 192.18 feet to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on the North Right of Way line of said S.W. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue; thence easterly, along said North Right of Way line of S.W. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 40', more or less, to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on the east Right of Way line of said S.W. 1st Street; thence North 01°17'13" West, along said East Right of Way line of S.W. 1st Street, 193.57 feet to a nail and disk (PSM 6602) on said South Right of Way line of S.W. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue; thence North 88°08'51" East, along said South Right of Way line of S.W. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, 200.08 feet to the Point of Beginning.
