FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES, AND KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 5th day of April , 2022 by and between the CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, a municipal corporation ("CITY"), and GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES ("GRU"), a Florida municipal corporation, and KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. ("CONSULTANT") a Foreign Profit Corporation authorized to do business in Florida, with its principal place of business at 421 Fayetteville Street, Suite 600, Raleigh, NC 27601, individually referred to as "Party" or collectively as "Parties", respectively.

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a contract on September 26, 2018 with a termination date September 30, 2023 ("Initial Contract") with no renewals, for the professional architectural and engineering consulting services on an asneeded basis; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Initial Contract, rates are firm for a minimum of one year and may be re-negotiated annually without changing the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have agree to an increase in the Consultant's rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and the covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- Parties agree to new billing rates submitted by consultant per Attachment A 2021 Hourly Rate Schedule. The 2021 Hourly Rate Schedule replaces the 2018 Billing Rate Schedule that was attached to the Initial Contract.
- Contractor shall continue to provide professional architectural and engineering consulting services in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Initial Contract.
- 3. The following section 19.10 is added to the Initial Contract:

19.10 E-VERIFY

Section 448.095, Florida Statute states the statute shall be construed in a manner so as to be fully consistent with any applicable federal laws or regulations. The Contractor shall (1) utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the Contractor during the term of the contract; and (2) shall expressly require any subcontractors performing work or providing services pursuant to the contract to likewise utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the contract term. Alternatively, Contractor shall provide proof that one of the exceptions to the E-Verify federal contractor rule applies.

4. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Initial Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
