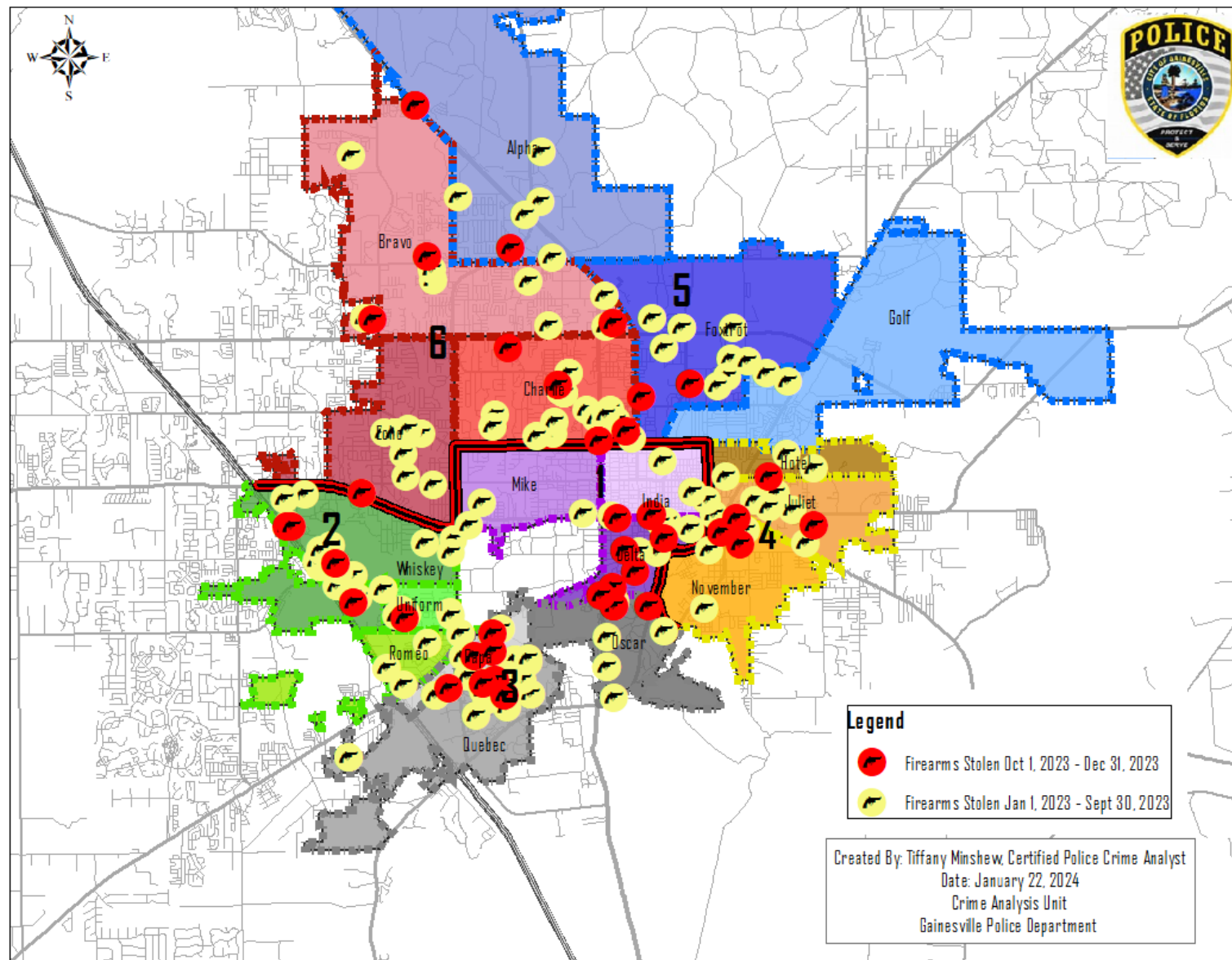

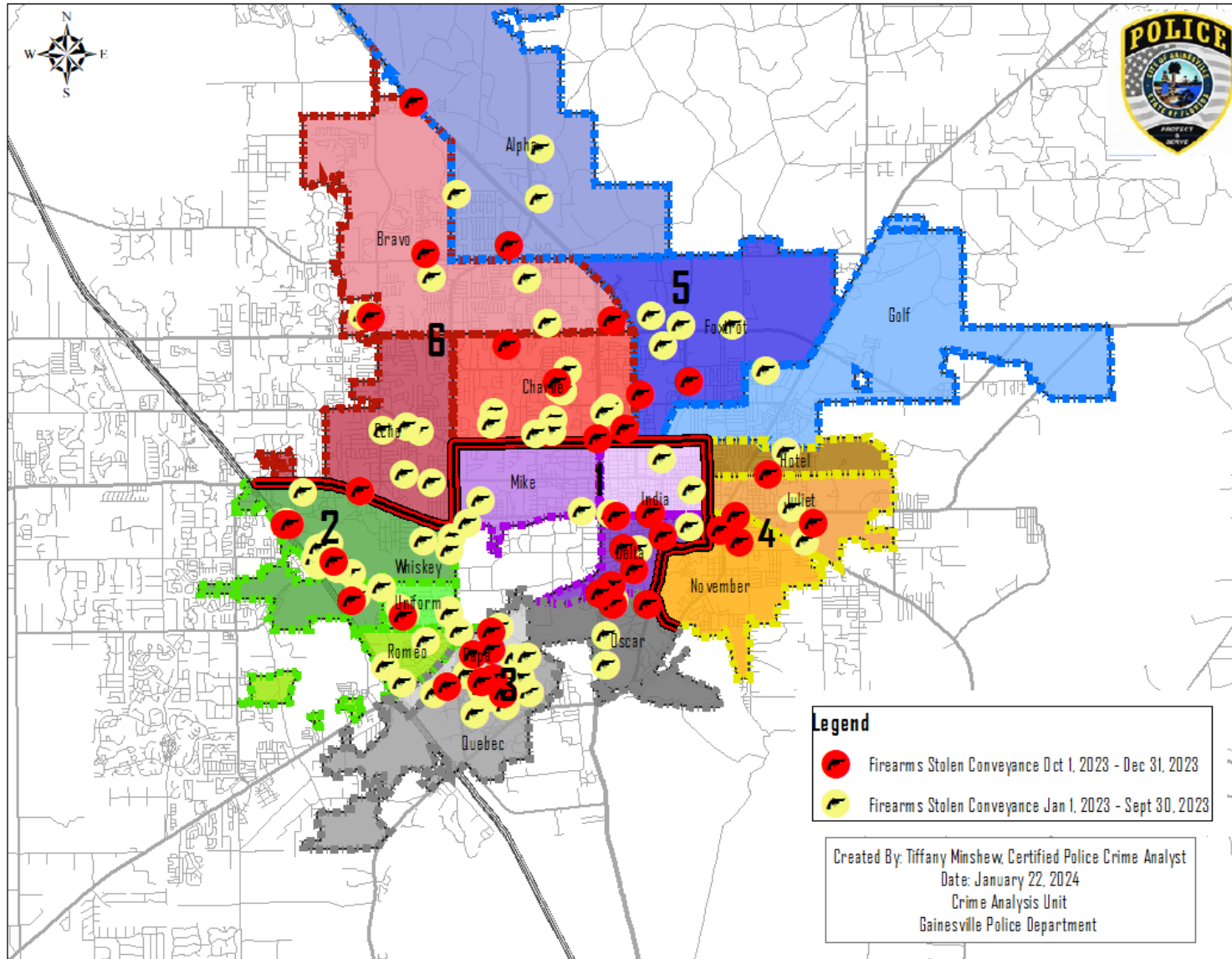

Conveyance Burglaries Incident Locations Involving Stolen Firearms

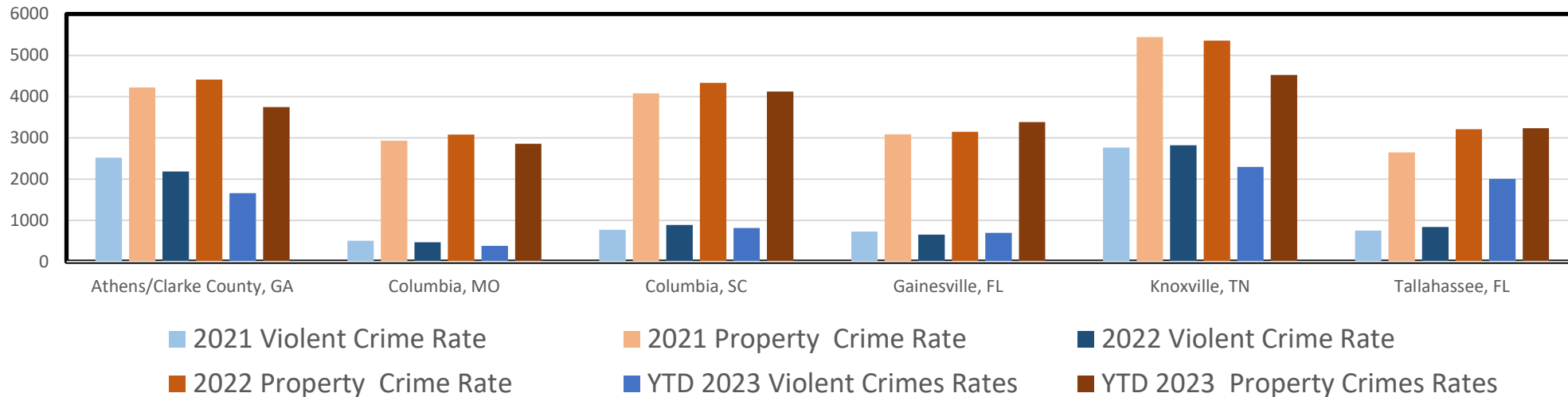

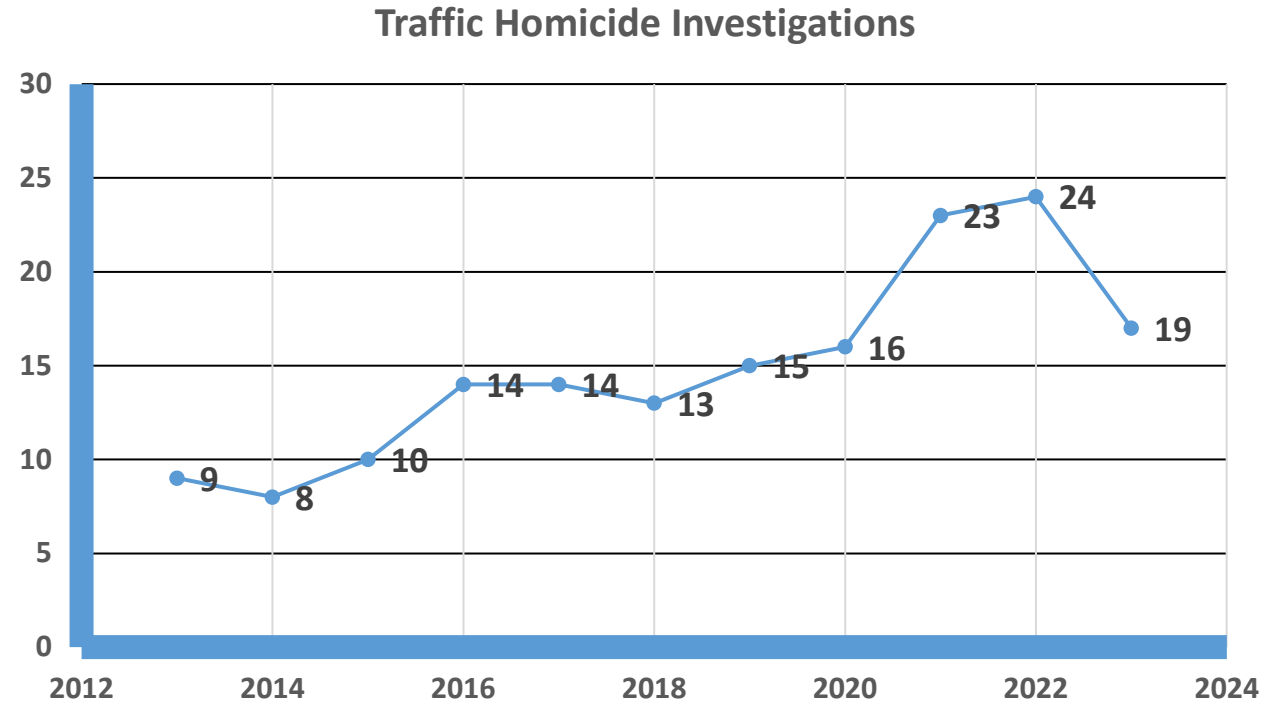

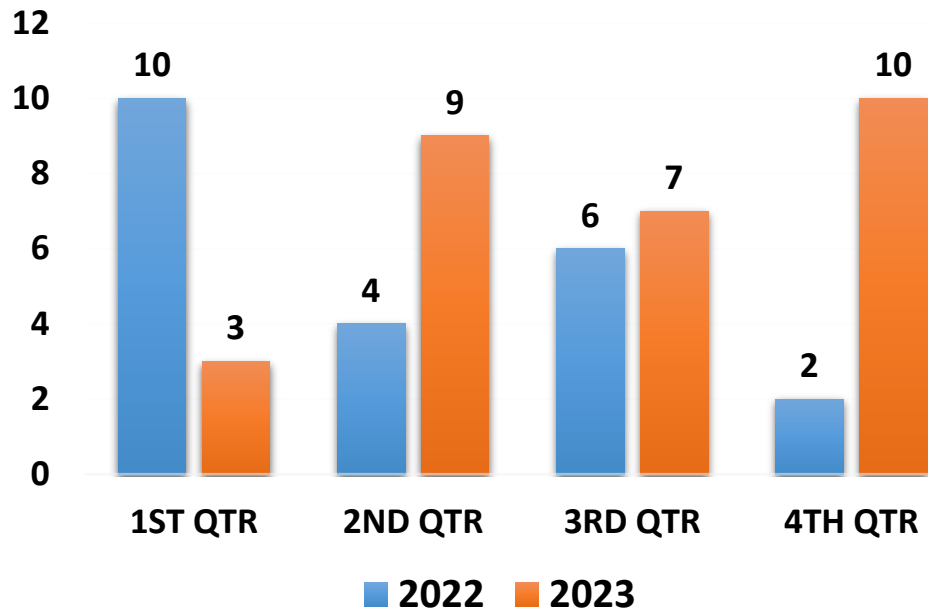

2023 TRAFFIC FATALITIES BY QUARTER

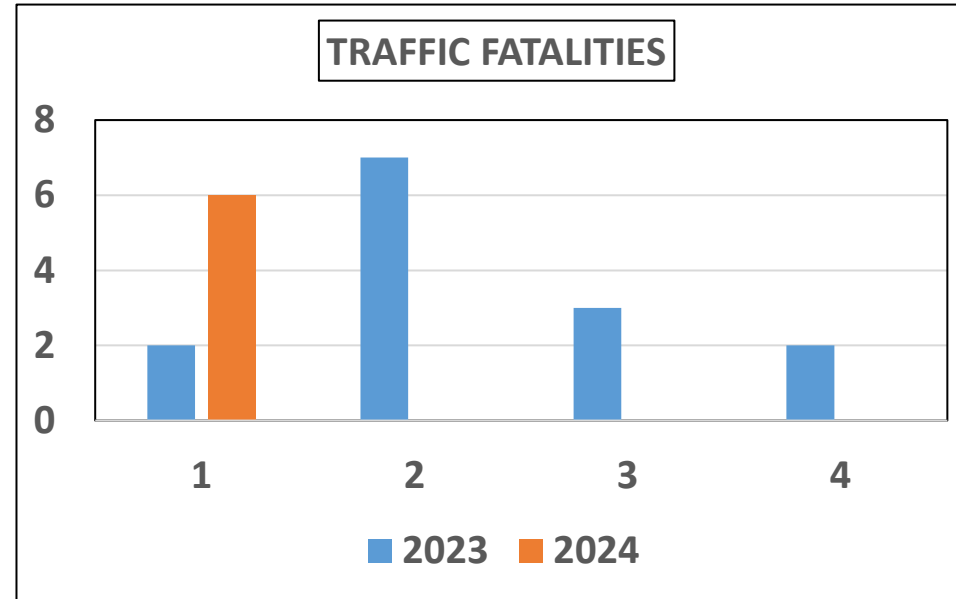
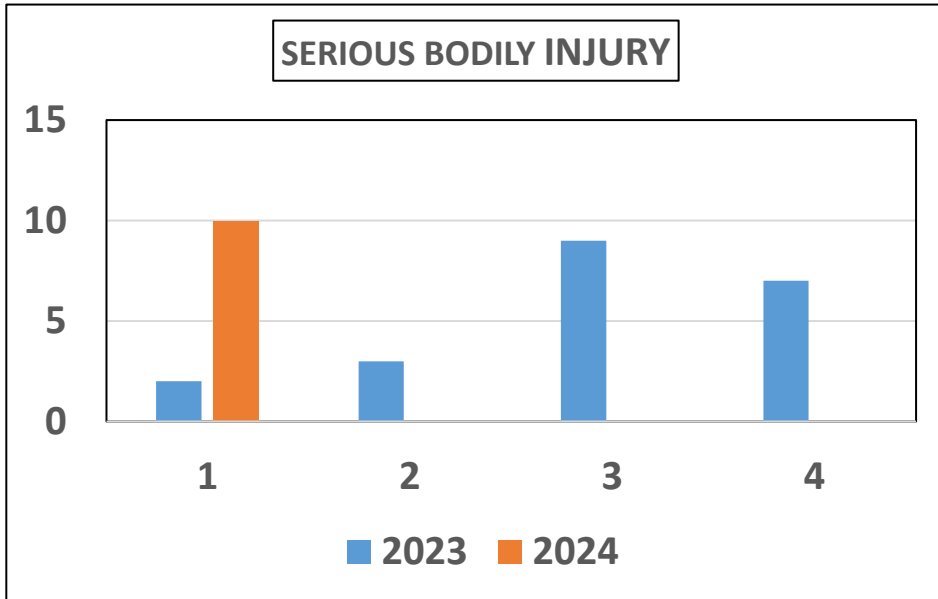


2024 Major Traffic Crashes October 1 – December 31, 2023



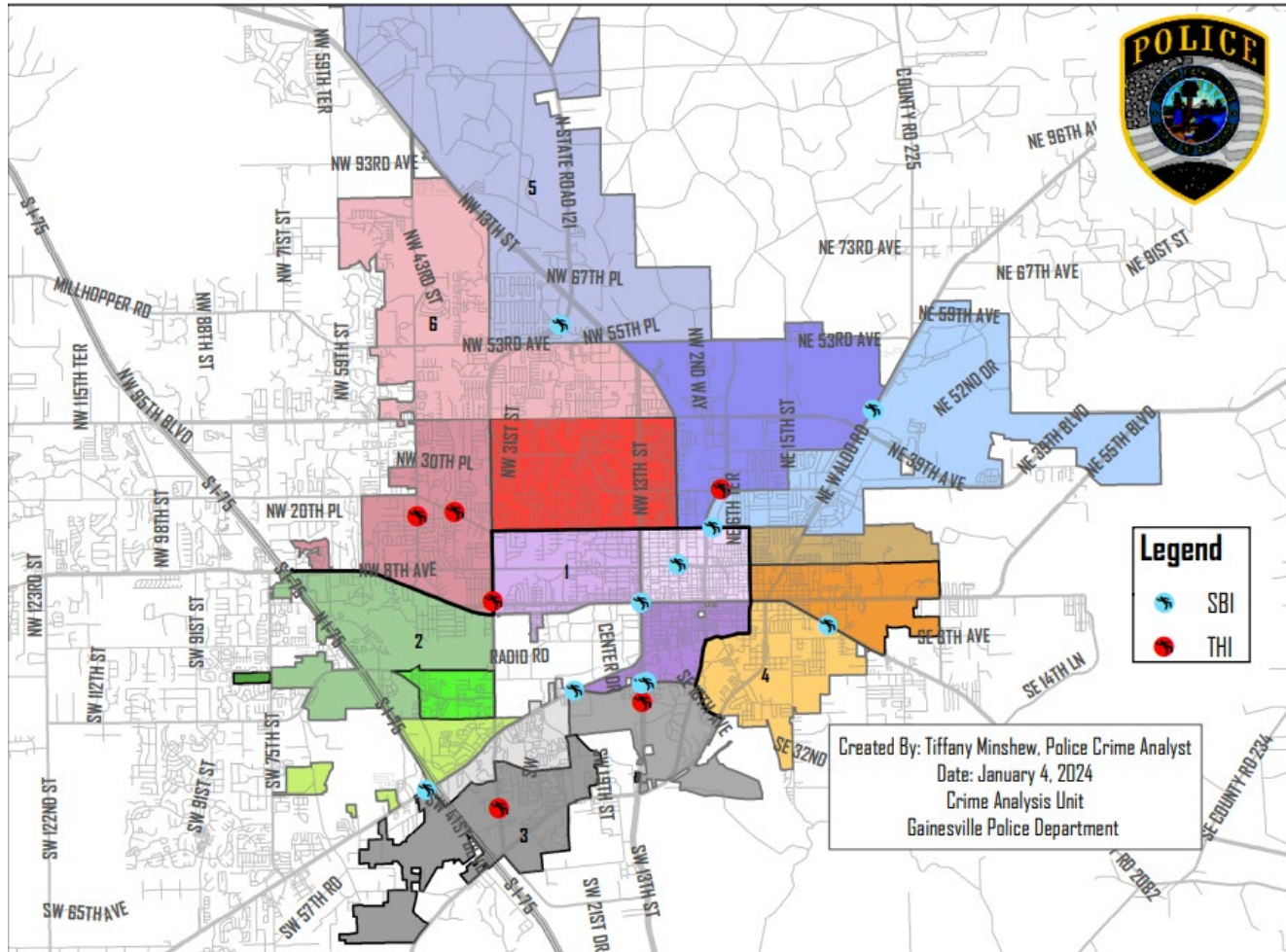
Bike or Pedestrian **serious bodily injury** crashes for quarter: **4**

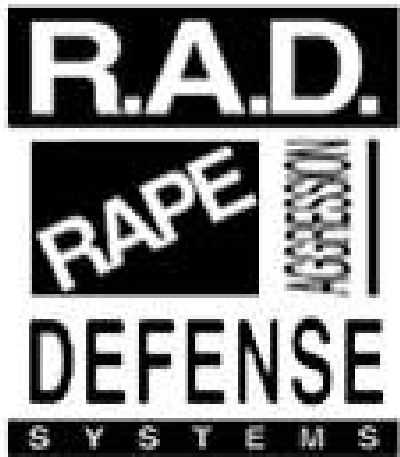

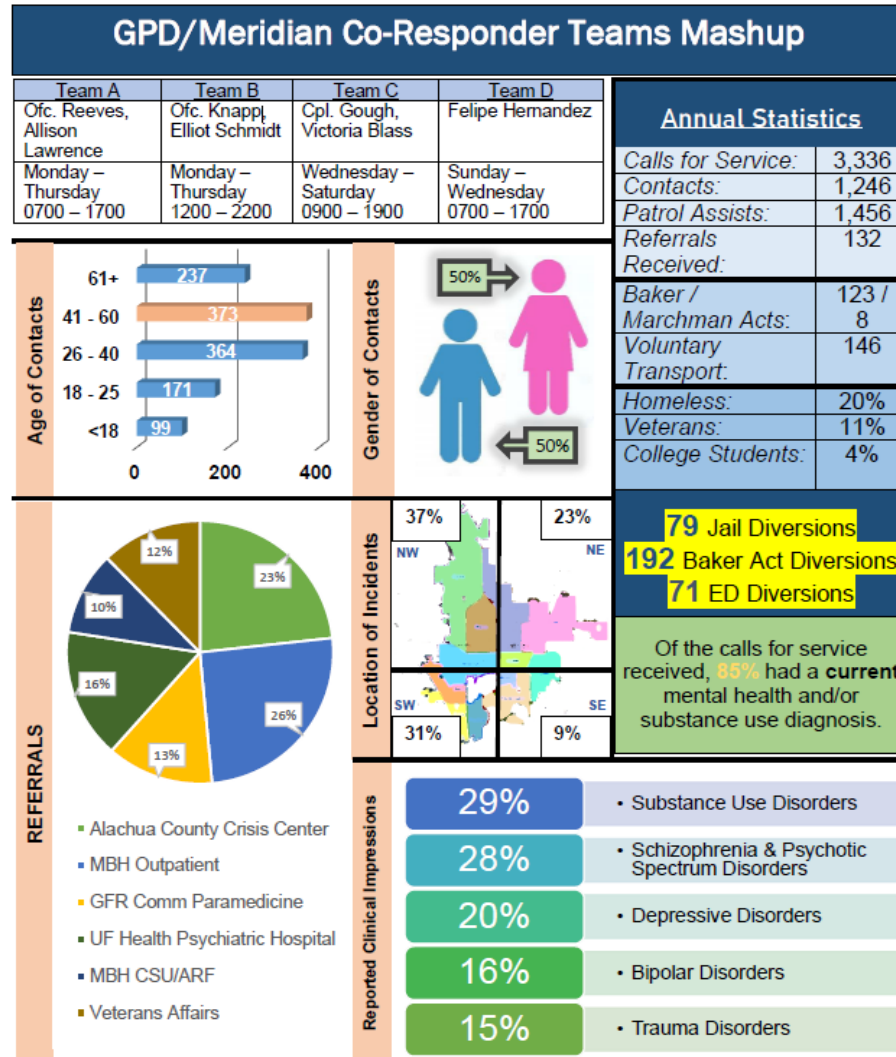

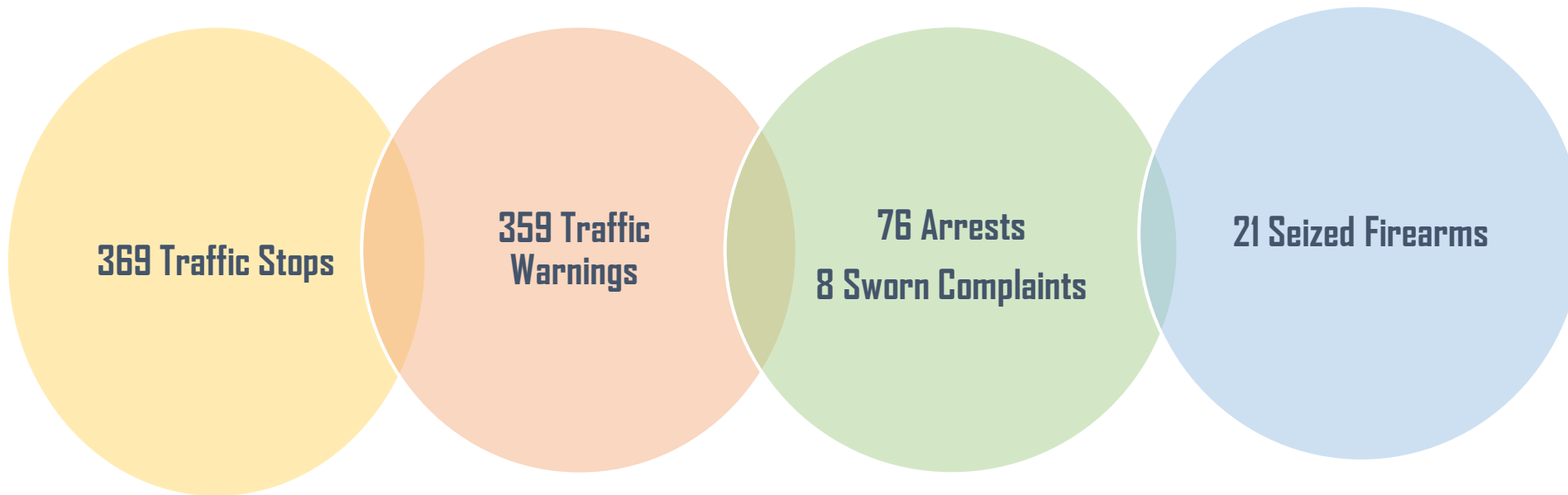
