HB 479 Alternative Mobility Funding - Authorizes local governments to adopt alternative mobility plan & fee system; providing definitions for "mobility fee" and "mobility plan"; requires that local governments collect for extra jurisdictional impacts if they are issuing building permits and prohibit local governments from assessing multiple charges for same transportation impact

Establishes a Florida Historic Tax Credit, covering 20% of eligible renovation costs of historic structures, and additional 30% tax credit for eligible costs for buildings in a certified Main Street community

HB 601 Complaints Against Police - Makes it _ unlawful for municipalities or citizen oversight boards to pass or enforce any ordinance relating to the receipt, processing or investigation of complaints of misconduct by law enforcement officers. The bills also prohibit the creation of any laws in relation to civilian oversight of a law enforcement agency in relation to the investigation of complaints

Homestead Exemption Bills

HB 7015 Increased Homestead Exemption – amendment to

FL Constitution to increase the max amount of the from \$25,000 to \$50,000, for homestead property w/assessed value greater than \$50,000

HB 7017 Homestead Exemption Value Adjustment –

amendment to FL Constitution for annual inflation adjustment to \$25K exemption and any future ones only when inflation growth is positive
