Title: 2024-201 Florida Department of Law Enforcement Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Countywide Grant Application (NB)

Department: Gainesville Police Department

Description: Request for City Commission to retroactively approve the application for federal pass-through Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Countywide from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.

Fiscal Note: If awarded, the City would receive \$28,204.00 and there are no match requirements for the award.

Explanation:

The Gainesville Police Department applied for its share of the \$97,910.00 of FY 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding available for award from Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for projects implemented by Law Enforcement Agencies in Alachua County. From the total available funding \$69,706.00 is to be distributed among Alachua County Sheriff's Office, Alachua Police Department, High Springs Police Department, and the University of Florida Police Department; and \$28,204.00 is to be allocated for use by GPD. If awarded, funding will be utilized by GPD for its Law Enforcement Equipment Enhancement program to equip the Forensics Unit with a handheld narcotics analyzer.

Sub-awards for projects must be committed/expensed by September 30, 2024.
